We present all of Kate Malone's work as her principal dealer, featuring her work in our exhibitions and catalogues as well as sending works of art to other galleries and museums on her behalf. Kate Malone's main studio is in Kent and her glaze archive is located in her small London studio.

Her work is often inspired by exotic travels and the growth patterns, ripeness and abundance seen in nature. Using strong colours and sumptuous crystalline glazes, her work communicates a 'feel good factor' through sculptural cladding of her forms with naturalistic and varied details.

Kate has become one of Britain's most highly regarded ceramic artists since graduating from the Royal College of Art, London, in 1986. Her work is collected internationally and represented in many major public collections.
